Registration steps for next year

1. Double check transcript on Infinite Campus. **If you see any problems or have questions about your transcript, see your counselor.** Check the Graduation Planner on your student page in Infinite Campus to see if you are on track with the graduation requirements.
2. SEVEN PERIOD DAY!!
3. Select courses (*use BSD pre-registration booklet and Timberline course offerings handout*)
 - A. 14 course requests (7-first semester and 7-second semester)
 - B. Choose 3-4 alternates like you would want the class!!
 - C. Zero hour class would mean 16 course requests.
 - D. Professional Tech class would equal 12 course selections.
4. COMPLETE ONLINE REGISTRATION BY FEBRUARY 28TH AND RETURN ANY APPLICATIONS OR RELEASE PERIOD FORMS TO COUNSELING OFFICE.
