Timberline Sophomore Classes/Activities

ENGLISH

Accelerated English 10

- ◆ Students and parents are encouraged to consult with the 9th grade English teacher regarding questions about student readiness to enroll in Acc. English 10

MATH

- ◆ Teacher will authorize placement.
- Seminar equals elective credit to assist with math class. Seminar is NOT the student's math class.

SCIENCE

Accelerated Chemistry (sophomore)

- ◆ "A" or "B" average in Accelerated Math or be an A+ student in regular math.
- ◆ Strong interest in Science.
- ◆ Remember that a Biology class must be taken for graduation.
- ◆ Check with science teacher for information and recommendation.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

- ◆ Sophomores involved in Athletics during one or both semesters can participate in Accelerated P.E. 10.
- ◆ Two PE 9-12 credits required for graduation.
- ◆ Personal Fitness: Non-competitive fitness class that meets graduation requirement
- ◆ **To play a sport next fall, you must pass 5 academic classes this semester!**

ELECTIVES

- ◆ This is a year long course!

ADVANCED PLACEMENT

FOREIGN LANGUAGE
